COURSE AIMS:

1. Understand the research and impact of the Word Gap upon children's attainment and well-being
2. Support the development of inclusive strategies that promote language development for all children
3. Develop practise to ensure the lowest 20% of children have rich language experiences that are effective in building vocabulary
4. Support staff in evaluating the impact of early language development
5. share findings with colleagues locally and nationally through an action research project published online

FACILITATOR:

The sessions are facilitated by Charlotte Raby who has over 20 years' experience in teaching, training, writing and educational consultancy. She has acted as a consultant for the Department for Education and is the lead lecturer in English at Essex and Thames Primary SCITT. Charlotte has been working with schools across the country developing early reading training and resources with a specific focus upon language and vocabulary.
