

iPad Training for Teachers

2015-2016



8th October 2015: Literacy and the iPad

Content : During this Mobile Learning session, participants will look at the iPad's place within reading and writing as well as speaking and listening. A hands on approach will ensure that each teacher gains a functional grasp of useful literacy apps. In doing so, the delegates will use the devices to enhance creative writing, independent reading, comprehension tests and multimodal opportunities. This is coupled with a focus on accessibility within literacy and the iPad's ability to offer differentiated learning in an innovative way.

Logistics: There will be an Opening Keynote before the delegates are split into two groups. Both groups will work with one Apple Specialist Trainer on Reading before swapping at the half way point to work with the other on Writing. Speaking and listening skills will be addressed throughout each workshop. All of the content will correlate across the two workshops.

25th February 2016: Numeracy and the iPad

Content: The 'Numeracy and the iPad' session focuses in on the iPad's ability to make a big impact on teaching and learning within day-to-day numeracy lessons. From a teaching point of view, we will look at how the iPad can help with mathematical assessments and testing. We will also delve into the wider provisions that this technology can offer when it comes to explanations and how the iPad can single handily help a child to retain mathematical information. When it comes to Numeracy learning, the cohort will explore the different ways that children can represent their work and the implications that this has on accessibility.

Logistics: There will be an Opening Keynote before the delegates are split into two groups. One group will go into a Numeracy Teaching workshop whilst the other goes into a Numeracy learning workshop. Again the groups will swap at the half way point. All of the content will correlate across the two workshops.

24th May 2016: Creativity and the iPad

Content: This session will take a more open ended approach due to the nature of the subject. Teachers will engage with the iPad's embedment within Musical Creativity, Artistic Endeavours and Performing Arts, as well as exploring Imaginative Teaching and Learning. The session will look at the technologies opportunity for creative choice in the classroom. We will also focus in on the iPad's ability to combine physical work with digital creativity and how that can expand on a child's ideas. In doing so, participants can expect to engage in a cross-curricular project that combines a series of different creative tools.

Logistics: There will be an Opening Keynote before the delegates are split into two groups. One group will go into an Art and Drama workshop whilst the other goes into a Musical Composition workshop. Again the groups will swap at the half way point. All of the content will correlate across the two workshops and will culminate in a finished project.
