## MA Transformational Leadership



This innovative programme challenges and enhances your leadership practice and improves your effectiveness in complex and unpredictable professional environments:

## Who is this programme for?

The MA Transformational Leadership programme is for all graduates who occupy or aspire to a leadership and management position at any level within educational contexts. Middle ('pivotal') and senior leaders and managers are most welcome but since leadership and management affect all in education, the programme would benefit you if you are not in such a formal role.

## Entry requirements

You should have a degree or equivalent level qualification. You would normally need access to an educational setting for research, for which most people use their own place of work. Credits may be brought in from other universities and National College programmes can be used to gain Master's level credits.



## Where will I study?

The programme can be delivered in a local venue, school based groups or at one of our university campuses. Sessions are generally run as twilights and on occasional Saturdays.

## Duration

3 years part-time.

## What will I study?

The programme comprises 6 modules each worth 20 credits and a dissertation worth 60 credits, (making a total of 180 credits for the full MA).

**You will study the following over the first two years:**

- Professional values and contexts
- Transformational leadership for communities and schools
- Transformational leadership: international perspectives
- Inclusive leadership
- Learning from good practice in leadership
- Leading the professional development of others
- Evaluation and research methods and dissertation.
