

TEACHING INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME 2019

This national programme, funded by the DfE is now in its third year & offering undergraduates in **Maths** or **Physics** related degrees the chance to experience a 4 week paid internship in a secondary school with a view to considering a career in teaching

South Essex Teaching School Alliance have secured funding to offer places to 6 Maths & 4 Physics interns in 2019.

Applicants will need to complete all necessary forms, give references, attend an interview and pass the standard safeguarding procedures (DBS).

Successful interns will complete the 4 week programme to include: induction; safeguarding; professional expectations; how to observe lessons; time in a primary/special school *and much more*.
